



## Volunteer Role Description

Role title:	<b>Local Representative</b>
Purpose of role:	To promote PaganAid to your local Pagan community, recruit new regular givers and raise funds.
Reporting lines:	Reports to the Volunteer Coordinator
Main duties:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To promote PaganAid at local open gatherings of Pagans, such as moots, conferences and public rituals. This may involve giving talks, handing out leaflets, displaying posters or organising a stall.</li> <li>2. To promote PaganAid within any closed Pagan groups that you are already a member of.</li> <li>3. To organise or encourage others to organise local fundraising events or activities.</li> <li>4. To keep the Volunteer Coordinator informed about your activities and pass on any feedback.</li> </ol>
Skills and qualities needed:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Passion for sustainable development and PaganAid's mission.</li> <li>2. Good interpersonal skills, able to talk to and build relationships with other Pagans.</li> <li>3. Good communications skills, able to talk clearly about PaganAid and what it is trying to achieve.</li> <li>4. Access to and ability to use on-line communications.</li> </ol>

Note that all volunteers are required to read PaganAid's Volunteer Policy and Communications Policy, and agree to act with honesty and without discrimination, in line with PaganAid's values and with its best interests at heart.
